There must be no talking or communication of any sort once you enter the exam hall. Do not touch or open the exam paper until you are told to do so.


**No mobile phones (even if they are turned off), MP3 players or any other electronic devices. No papers/notes/books (even in pockets) can be taken into the exam.**
