

- Nouns a person, place, thing or idea
 - o Proper noun particular, e.g name, place, month, day
 - o Common noun people or things in general not specific and not a proper noun
 - o Concrete noun physical, you can touch it
 - Collective noun groups of people or things
 - Abstract noun ideas, qualities and conditions cannot be seen or touched and have no physical reality
- Pronoun used in place of a noun
 - o Personal pronoun refers to specific people (I, me, you, his, etc.)
- Verb doing or happening
 - o Modal verb shows possibility, intention or ability (must, shall, will, should, would, ought, can, could, may and might)
- Adjective describes a noun
- Adverb describes a verb, adjective or another adverb
- **Preposition** describes the position of something or the time when something happens
- Conjunction/connective connects phrases, clauses and sentences.
- Determiner/article introduces a noun (a/an, the, every, this, those, many)
 - o Definite article = the
 - o Indefinite article = a/an
- Interjection/exclamation word or phrase expressing strong emotion (Ow! Hello!)
